# **Point Peron is under attack!**



If the Barnett Government's proposed private canal housing and inland marina development at Point Peron goes ahead we risk impacts including;

- Reduced pedestrian access to the beachfront along Mangles Bay because the marina entry will **cut the beach in half** and beach walkers will have to walk around the canal housing development in order to get to the far side of the beach.
- <u>Damage</u> to juvenile fish nurseries and fish stocks due to <u>destruction of 6 ha of</u> <u>seagrass</u> from dredging the entrance channel.
- Rate increases to fund the ongoing dredging needed to keep the access channel open and for maintenance of canal seawalls (as has happened in Yunderup).
- Stagnant water due to poor flushing of the canals resulting in <u>reduced local property</u> <u>values</u>
- Dewatering during construction causing **bores within 1 km to dry up** and or become salty causing trees to die (as has happened in Mandurah)
- Bulldozing nearly one third of Point Peron's bushland, making the remaining habitat unviable for wildlife, and replacing the bushland with festering canals and **buildings** up to 5 storeys high!!!


